Guidelines for Selecting a Campground

1. Must be able to accommodate 20-25 coaches some as large as 42 feet long and have relatively easy access from nearby highways.
2. Must have a suitable shelter: outdoor is okay for all months except April, May and October when an indoor space is necessary. Shelter should be in reasonable access to the camp sites for the benefit of members with limited mobility.
3. Must have water and electric hook-ups with adequate dump stations or full service.
4. Clean, well maintained shower/restroom facilities.
5. Preferably within 75 miles of the I-275 beltway.
6. Activities and amenities preferred or close proximity to points of interest.
7. Pets welcome at no extra charge.
8. Rates affordable for all members.
9. Check the refund policy

Cross Campground, Camden, OH - worth a visit - \$23 with one night deposit which is not refundable.

Eagle Valley Camping Resort, Sanders, KY - separate charges for each activity on site (swimming, mini-golf, etc.) Special advance payment requirements during racing season: May - August

Lazy Dog Camp Resort, Jackson, OH - \$25-30 full service - Distance may be a problem (located near intersection of rtes. 32 & 93 east of Cincinnati).

Oak Creek Campground, Walton, KY - \$27 for water & electric only

Tomorrow's Stars RV Resort, Springfield, OH - decent reviews on the internet.

Whitewater Campground, Connersville, IN - Water & electric, few trees

Wolfes Family Kamping, Zanesville, OH \$28-29 - rated well in Woodall's and others - many amenities - large
